Instrumentation Technician

The instrumentation lab is the final step in the process of analysis for most samples. Instrumentation Technicians are responsible for maintaining sample throughput by manually running analyses as required, loading auto-sampler racks and keeping work organized. The primary instruments used are AA and ICP Spectrometers. An understanding of the chemistry and calculations involved in producing an accurate result is required to ensure that analyses are consistently and accurately performed according to our Quality System.

Requirements

- Post secondary education in chemistry or a related field, or 5 years experience in a similar position
- Shift work as required by a 24/7 operation (40 hours per week)
- Attention to detail while performing a repetitive task
- Manual dexterity and comfortable working with acids
- Computer skills beneficial as instruments are computer controlled and results generated in a spreadsheet-like application
